

# Viewing Sleep-eze in detail





When setting the Sleep-eze in your ear, the volume control is at the top, and the engraved serial number faces forward, towards your nose. The right unit has a red dot near the volume wheel and the letter "R" in front of the serial #. Left unit has a blue dot near volume, and "L" in front of serial #.

# **Proper Tip Selection**

Two types of tips come with the unit:

## Insertion Into Ear


(1st) Pull back & up to straighten ear canal



(3rd) Insert by placing finger on face of unit, gently wiggling it into the ear.

## **Adjusting Volume Control**

Put gentle pressure against the volume control with your index finger. Slowly turn the control forward towards your nose for louder, and backwards toward back of head for softer.



### **Removing & Turning Off**

NOTE: The smallest Fan tip is already on the unit.

Use whichever style is more comfortable. If the fit is

not snug, remove the tip from the unit and put on

another size, until your Sleep-eze feels snug and

Use removal cord only, to extract the Sleep-eze from your ear.



Open the battery door to turn the unit off.



# **Cleaning And Care**

**Installing The Battery**

Use the brush or cleaning tool on a regular basis. Brush the tip of your Sleep-eze to clear away any wax. Use a cloth

moistened with alcohol on the ear tip; dry the end.

Store Sleep-eze in the included storage pouch when not in use.
